



LLumar® SCL SR PS8 Now Meets GSA Federal Building Shatter-Resistant Window Protection Requirements

The **GSA's Leasing Desk Guide** details the policies for Federal Government-occupied space in buildings and requires "shatter-resistant window protection."

Recently reformulated LLumar SCL SR PS8, launched in 2018, now meets the GSA requirements for shatter-resistant window protection.

From the GSA Leasing Desk Guide (p19-44): The Lessor shall provide and install shatter-resistant material not less than 0.18 millimeters (0.007 inches or 7 mils) thick on all exterior windows in Government-occupied space meeting the following minimal properties:
